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#### **FEES**

Fees MUST be paid in the 1<sup>st</sup> week of each ½ term

By working out your own child's fees it helps us to keep administration costs down and therefore the fees=£10 x No of sessions x weeks (autumn term 14 weeks/spring =11week/summer =13).

#### Lunch box club =£4

Children (in term past their 3rd birthday) are entitled to 15 hours = 5 sessions per weekmorning or afternoon at Playschool- Once sessions are booked onto certain days they are set and are non negotiable or transferable.

1 lunch box session counts as a funded session.

# **HEALTH & SAFETY/ALLERGIES**

HEALTH - In order to keep the Playschool open it is vital THAT ALL PARENTS/CARERS RESPECT OUR HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY = Children must not attend Playschool if suffering from ANY ILLNESS and for SICKNESS AND/OR DIARRHOEA. YOUR child must be clear of / any symptoms for 48 hours. If in doubt please contact a doctor.

<u>FOOD ALLERGIES</u> - do not include any <u>peanuts OR</u> <u>peanut butter</u> in your child's packed lunch, or products that state they contain peanuts (don't worry about products that state 'packed in area that may contains nuts' etc).

# **WINTER FOREST SCHOOL CLOTHES**

# <u>Please provide the following for your child's comfort = named WELLIES</u>

- 3 layers of clothing & thick socks inc <u>VEST, LONG SLEEVE T-SHIRT & JUMPER & LONG TROUSERS OR LEGGINGS</u> (to protect from brambles.
- 2. Named <u>warm</u> waterproof coat.
- 3. Named hat and gloves.

#### **CLOTHING**

Playschool children need clothes that help them play & explore.

# They need a warm waterproof coat every day as the outdoors is part of the learning environment.

Please dress children in old play clothes which encourage mobility for easy running and outdoor and messy play. Your children will be more comfortable and have more fun. You will be happier if you don't dress them in an expensive outfit only to have it ruined or stained. Flip-flops and sandals (crocs) are not practical for running & it can inhibit their physical development.
